#### CELTIC-NEXT vs DOMESTIC APPLICATION PROCESS

- NCBR in principle supports all projects with Polish participation
- We strive to fund as many as possible
- BUT unable to take a funding decision ourselves on the basis of CELTIC-NEXT-labelled FPP
- Domestic application needs to be submitted
- It is then evaluated formally by NCBR and on merit by 3 external, independent experts
- Current EUREKA Network Projects Call in Poland: 17 May 18 October 2024
- Next year's Network Projects Call: most probably from 19 May to 17 October 2025
- No thematical preferences civilian purpose is a prerequisite
- Allocation: PLN 5 m (approx. EUR 1m)
- SMEs may apply individually or as consortia members
- Academia and large enterprises eligible for funding, but only as members of SME-comprising consortia
- Max. funding amount per single applicant (SME): PLN 750K
- Max. funding amount per domestic consortium (SME + at least 1 more entity): PLN 1,5m

University/research institute	100%	
Micro/small enterprise	80%	70%
Medium-sized enterprise	80%	60%
Large enterprise	75%	50%
